1.0. UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES (BACHELOR DEGREES)

General Admission requirements: Eligible applicants for admission to any Bachelor programme should possess: -

(a) Direct (UACE) Entry Scheme

At least **Two (2) Principal Passes** at Uganda Advanced Certificate of Education (UACE) or its equivalent, **and** at least **Five (5) Passes** at Uganda Certificate of Education (UCE) obtained at the same sitting or its equivalent. **or**

(b) Diploma Holders Entry Scheme

At least a **Second Class** or **Credit Diploma** in a relevant field of study, **and** Uganda Advanced Certificate of Education (UACE) with at least **One (1) Principal Pass** and **Two (2) Subsidiary Passes** or its equivalent, and Uganda Certificate of Education (UCE) with at least **Five (5) passes** obtained at the same sitting or its equivalent. **or**

(c) Mature Age Exam Certificate Holders Entry Scheme

Mature Age Examination Certificate in a relevant field with at least a 50% mark, sat at a NCHE recognized Centre and obtained NOT more than two (2) years ago. **or**

(d) Higher Education Certificate Holders Entry Scheme

At least a **Credit** in Higher Education Certificate in a relevant field (General, Humanities, Business, Biological or Physical Sciences) from a NCHE recognized Institution.

NOTE: Admitted and registered students on the Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE) programme are taught the **Professional Education Courses, Teaching Methods** for the respective content subjects offered at degree level, and later undergo **School Practice** in order to qualify as teachers/instructors.

3.0. HIGHER EDUCATION ACCESS PROGRAMME (HEAP)

- 3.1. **Programme description.** The Higher Education Access Programme (formerly known as Higher Education Certificate - HEC) is the **fourth route/avenue of admission into Diploma or Degree programmes approved by National Council for Higher Education (NCHE)**, for persons who do not have requisite/appropriate qualifications based on the current Uganda National Admission criteria; and persons with foreign qualifications but do not merit for admission in the Ugandan Education System. The Higher Education Access Programme is a one Academic Year (i.e., Two Semesters) intensive pre-undergraduate bridging/access/foundational programme in specific subject combinations focused towards a particular career progression. **Note that successful students who obtain Class II (Credit) or Class I (Distinction) are eligible for admission into Bachelors Degree programmes, while those who obtained Class III (Pass) are eligible for admission into Diploma programmes in any University/Higher Education Institution in Uganda.**
- 3.2. **Admission requirements.** Eligible applicant **MUST** possess:
- 3.2.1. **Direct entry (UACE).** Uganda Advanced Certificate of Education with **Two (2) Subsidiary Passes** in Principal Subjects obtained at the same sitting. **Note that Applicants who obtained One (1) Principal Pass and Two (2) Subsidiary Passes and above in Principal Subjects are deemed to be overqualified, and thus are not admissible to HEAP.**
- 3.2.2. **Vocational Qualifications.** Vocational qualifications at **level 2** or **level 3** of Uganda Vocational Qualifications framework.
- 3.2.3. **Holder of foreign Qualifications:** Foreign qualification of UACE equivalent with an **overall grade of C** (Students who obtained their Secondary School qualifications that are not considered to be equivalent to UACE but permit admission into Higher Education in their countries) In addition, foreign students whose studies were not conducted in English shall show proof of proficiency in the English Language.
- 3.2.4. **Qualifications equivalent** to Uganda Advanced Certificate of Education (UACE) as shall be determined by the National Council for Higher Education (NCHE) and/ or Uganda National Examinations Board (UNE) where applicable.
- 3.2.5. **Ordinary Certificate** in relevant discipline from NCHE recognized institution.

APPLICATION IS ONLINE. Please follow the online application procedure below to apply. The applicant **MUST** have an active **email address**, and a **Mobile phone number**.


- 4.1. To apply, log in: <https://admissions.muni.ac.ug/> (you may use internet web browsers e.g., Google Chrome, Firefox, Mozilla, Opera etc.)
- 4.2. Click **SIGN UP** button using full name, e-mail and mobile number. Please note that your name must be similar to the one on your supporting documents for your application to be accepted by the system.
- 4.3. **A six-digit code/password will be sent to both your e-mail.** The system will prompt you to **Change the Password** to the one you can easily remember.
- 4.4. To fill application form, click on **"APPLY NOW"** on the running schemes. Scroll down and select appropriate scheme [i.e., (i) Direct Entry (**Holders of UACE only**); (ii) Diploma Entry (**Holders of Diploma Qualifications only**), (iii) Bachelor of Education – BED (**applicants for BED-P, & BED-S**); (iv) Higher Education Certificate Holders (**applicants who possess HEC/HEAC/HEAP only**); (v) Mature Age Entry (**Applicants who sat and passed Mature Age examination from a recognized Centre**); (vi) Graduate Studies (**applicants for Postgraduate Diplomas and Masters**); and (vii) Higher Education Certificate (**Applicants to HEAP only**).
- 4.5. Once all details/ information fields are filled correctly and accurately, click **"SUBMIT FORM"**. The system will highlight in "red" colour any un-filled field.
- 4.6. Attach your SCANNED Academic documents by clicking on **"ATTACH FILES"** (Please note that the system will not allow you to proceed to payments if you have not attached your academic documents).
- 4.7. Obtain a payment slip by clicking **"PAY FOR FORM"** button and get **PAYMENT REFERENCE NUMBER**. **Select either Bank or Mobile Money (i.e., MTN or Airtel).**
- 4.8. Use the Payment Reference Number to pay a non-refundable application fee: East Africans **Ug. Shs. 50,000** or Other Nationals **Ug. Shs. 183,000**, at any Bank branch (**or Authorized Bank Agents**) or through Mobile Money (MTN or Airtel). Note that application fees exclude bank/transaction charges.
- 4.9. **Mobile Money Dial-up option (MTN- *165*4*5*1*1#, then enter PRN); WHILE (Airtel- *185*4*7*1#, then enter PRN).**

5.0. OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION

- 5.1. Before you commence the Online Application process, **SCAN COPIES OF ACADEMIC DOCUMENTS** (as a **single file in PDF format and not exceeding 1 GB**).
- 5.2. Holders of Diploma and Degree and/or Professional qualifications **MUST** attach **certified** copies of academic documents.
- 5.3. Only **correctly filled, complete and paid-up applications** will be processed for selection and admission purposes. **Beware that the system will not process any incorrect/miss-matched results data/information.**
- 5.4. Successful applicants admitted to undergraduate programmes on private sponsorship may apply for student loan scheme on specific programmes once the advert for 2026/2027 Academic Year is published.
- 5.5. **The University reserves the right to admit applicants or roll-out advertised programme only when the required number of qualifying applicants has been realized.**
- 5.6. Applicants are advised to print and keep copy of the application form together with payment slip for future use.
- 5.7. University fees relating to East Africans applies to all applicants/nationals from the East African Community (i.e., Uganda, Kenya, Tanzania, Rwanda, Burundi, DRC, South Sudan and Somalia).
- 5.8. The Admission List for applicants for Bachelors, Postgraduate Diplomas and Masters programmes is expected to be officially released by 20th June 2026. **While Admission List for applicants to Higher Education Access Programme (HEAP) is expected to be released by 1st May 2026.**
