PLEASE NOTE:

- [1]. Cut-off points/minimum points are relative, and therefore NOT fixed, but they vary from one intake to another, and from one university to another. Cut-off points are influenced by three (3) factors; **(a)** number of applicants for a course/programme, **(b)** performance of the applicants (UACE plus UCE, and where applicable 1.5 points for female), and **(c)** programme capacity (the approved admissible number/available slots) for a particular year of admission. In effect, cut-off points are determined during the actual selection of the applicants for admission, and NOT before!
- [2]. However, the minimum admission requirements to a Bachelor's Degree programme under Direct Entry Scheme (UACE/A' Level) is; at least **Two (2) Principal Passes** at Uganda Advanced Certificate of Education (UACE) obtained at the same sitting, **Essential** to the course/programme of study or its equivalent, **and** at least **Five (5) Passes** at Uganda Certificate of Education (UCE) obtained at the same sitting or its equivalent.
