On behalf of University Management and Staff, I take this opportunity to congratulate you upon your admission to Muni University. I wish to inform you as follows:

- 1.0. Admission list/s can be viewed at all University Notice boards, and/or downloaded from the University Website at: <http://www.muni.ac.ug>.
- 2.0. **Admission Letters for the under listed admitted applicants will be ready for collection from The Office of The Academic Registrar, Muni University, Main Campus in Arua City, with effect from July 2, 2026, during official working days, 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.**
 - 2.1. Government Sponsorship
 - (a) Direct Entry- National Merit, and (b) Diploma Holders' Scheme.
 - 2.2. Private Sponsorship
 - (a) Master's Degree and Postgraduate Diploma Programmes,
 - (b) Bachelor's Degree Programmes, and
 - (c) Higher Education Certificate (HEC).
- 3.0. Details about commencement and reporting for the new Academic Year, Semester Schedule, University Fees, Semester Registration, and other pertinent information have been communicated in the Admission Letter.
- 4.0. For purposes of collecting admission letter/s, you are required to present identification (i.e., former School/College/University Student ID or National ID or Driving Permit or Passport). It MUST be emphasized that Admission Letters shall only be issued to persons who present authentic identification.
- 5.0. Admission letters will not be issued to third party, unless officially authorized by the admitted applicant. Authorized persons are required to present copy of the applicant's identification (in 4.0 above) before they are issued the admission letter.
- 6.0. You are advised to keep your Admission Letter secure and safe; as there is no provision for replacement once it's lost.
- 7.0. FURTHER NOTE THAT,
 - 7.1. Failure to collect your admission letter, and register with the University within the stipulated period, you will forfeit (lose) your place in the University.
 - 7.2. In as much as lists for selected applicants under the Government District Quota, Talented Sports men and women, and Disability schemes were released in various media, admissions are NOT yet complete!
 - 7.3. In particular, the admission of applicants under District Quota scheme awaits verification by their Districts and confirmation by Ministry of Education and Sports.
 - 7.4. The 2nd Batch of Admission List will be released by 8th July 2026, for applicants who responded to the Second and Third Calls for Applications between 1st – 22nd June, and 24th June - 1st July 2026, respectively, including; BED-P, BED-S, and other “Mop-up” cases.
